CEASE THE GREASE!!! / WHAT CUSTOMERS CAN DO TO HELP!!!

NEVER

Never flush paper towels, tampon applicators, cotton swabs, matchsticks or similar items

Never use hot water to melt grease so it will go down the drain easier.

Never put oils, liquid or solid greases, fatty meat or other food scraps down a drain or a motorized garbage disposal

ALWAYS

Dispose of household liquid grease and oils in tightly capped containers.

Keep grease out of the wash water by scraping dishes before washing.

Dispose hardened grease and food scraps in the trash

REPORT

Acts of vandalism on manholes, sewer lines, lift stations, fire hydrants and other structures.

Report illegal dumping of toxic, corrosive, or flammable substances into manholes, drains or toilets.

Report overflowing manholes, sewer pipes, or pump stations.

Many foods contain fats, oils, and grease that build up over time in sewer pipes and can cause clogs and overflows into your home or neighborhood.

Avoid putting bacon grease, salad dressing, butter and meat scraps down your kitchen drain. Instead, Can it; Scrape it; Trash it; to dispose of your cooking fats, oils, and grease.
